Last year it was Restoration Hardware. This year, we find ourselves drawn to Room&Board, Allan Copley and Italian designer Antonio Calligaris for a clean line of home furnishings that has its roots in the past.

If you are unfamiliar with the Mid-Century Modern aesthetic, we invite you to read on! "Mid-Century Modern" refers to a design concept that generally became popular in the 1950s and is applied to architecture, interiors and furnishings. Architectural greats, such as Ludwig Mies van der Rohe and George Fred Keck, gave rise to the Mid-Century Modern style that is often considered industrial and experimental in form.

We like the crisp lines offered by the Mid-Century Modern movement and feel that the art, furniture and accessories featured look at home amid the clean architectural lines that define this year's *Green Dream Home*. But, not to worry, we haven't gone all modern. Every space has been softened with a warm color palette and surface texture - blurring the line between traditional and modern. Some might even call it a modern classic.
